Please ensure that your Proposal is compliant with the requirements contained in **the Fixed Call for Proposals CfP/5-5-50110/24/NL/MH/yd and CfP/5-50107/24/NL/MH/yd documentation** that will be published on esa-star Publication.

Lithuania signed the Associate Member (AM) agreement on 28 April 2021 and went into force on 21 May 2021:

- The RPA scheme is part of the AM agreement and is a funding scheme with a minimum contribution of 500k EUR per year, to further develop the national space industry.
 - **Lithuania is actually contributing more than this!**
- RPA aims at providing support to Lithuanian entities to overcome market entry barriers and reach a competitive level for successful participation in *multinational ESA programmes*.

The goals are:

- To prepare industry to be competitive in the ESA optional programmes that Lithuania subscribes to;
- To develop the competences that enable the country to contribute to new ESA optional programmes;
- To support space science activities (should Lithuanian government wish);
- To ensure that a highly educated workforce is available in the country for space related activities.

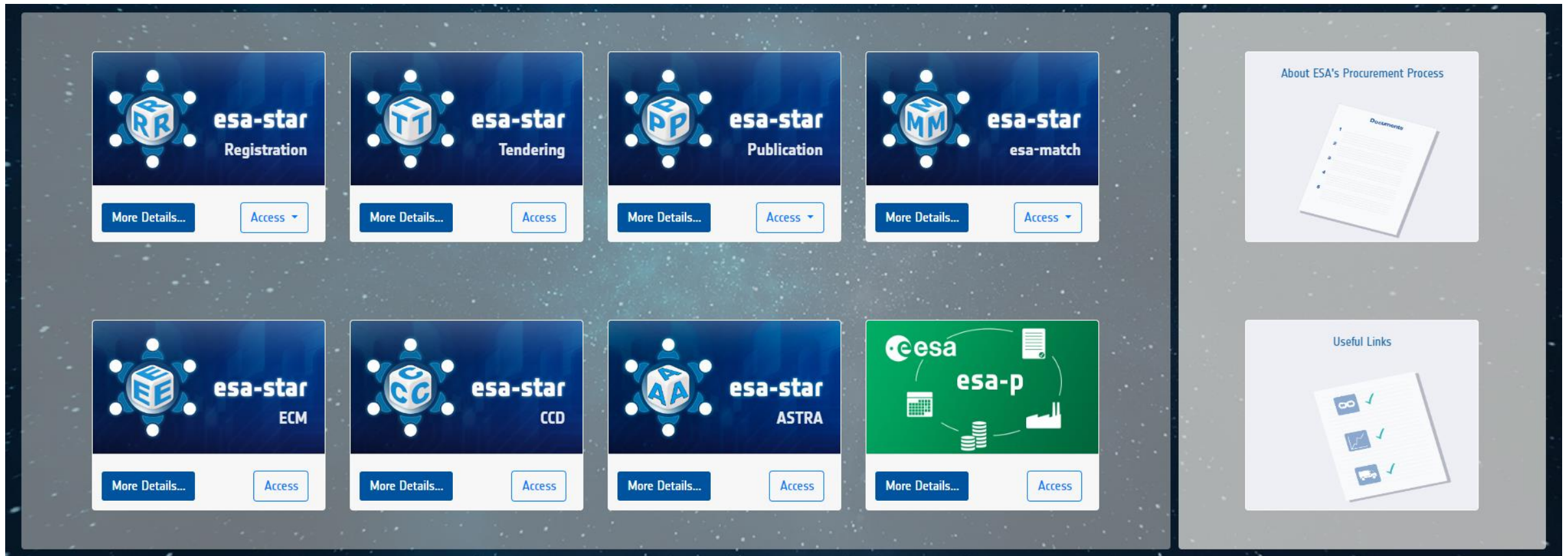
